What is Extra!?

Extra! contains 16 pages of great content for your pupils including seven pages of social science activities, current events quizzes, New Zealand and world mapping and focus on current issues. Photos of contributing pupils are also published with their writing. It is used by schools throughout the country



Last year more than 3500 pupils attended these very popular educational events.


Winning schools receive plaques, medals and book voucher prizes and all placegetters also receive book voucher prizes, courtesy of the *Otago Daily Times*.
